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ABOUT THIS DIRECTORY AND HOW TO USE IT

Information about staying healthy is easy to come by if you are hearing, but very little is made available in sign language for deaf people. That's part of the reason that deaf people are generally not as healthy as hearing people. Information on common illnesses and advice on how to keep yourself healthy can be hard to come by in sign language.

Healthwatch Bexley produced this health directory which provides a selection of information video's in British sign language, or with subtitles, on a variety of health and wellbeing topics. The videos provide advice about different illnesses and diseases as well as some self-help guides.

The health videos can be accessed by holding down the control key on your keyboard and clicking on the relevant link.

Contact NHS 111 services if you are worried you have coronavirus, you have travelled within the last 14 days OR may have come in contact with someone who has coronavirus. Call NHS 111 in BSL by visiting interpreternow.co.uk/nhs111 or use their app on your mobile device. Or use the NHS 111 online service at 111.nhs.uk/covid-19. **Do not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital.**



PREPARING FOR A GP VISIT

Visiting the doctor can be a stressful experience if you are deaf, but it is vital that communication barriers don't stop you from going and interfere with your health.

Before visiting your doctor, be sure of what you want to ask and the help you want to get. Inform the GP surgery that you are deaf and need an interpreter. It is the surgery's responsibility to book an interpreter for you. If you are deaf, or hard of hearing, it is important to have an interpreter when visiting your doctor. This is especially true if you speak sign language. A person who can sign to you what the doctor is saying will help you communicate better. You may want an interpreter even if you read lips and use spoken language. You may not be familiar with some of the terms your doctor uses. This can make it more difficult to read his or her lips.

You may want to ask a friend or relative to be your interpreter. But you should know that interpreters should be trained. Using a friend or family member could put you at risk if they misinterpret something during your visit. Also, your doctor may need to ask personal questions. Make sure you are comfortable enough to answer those questions through your interpreter.

If you have trouble hearing, tell the receptionist that calling your name isn't the best way to tell you that the doctor is ready to see you. Ask him or her to come and get you or get your attention visually when the doctor is ready for you.
